



ADVANCED CERTIFICATE IN RESEARCH AND EMBROIDERY

Aims:

To benefit The Embroiderers' Guild of South Australia Inc. by extending and documenting embroidery knowledge.

To benefit the participant through an in-depth study of an embroidery related topic.

Length: 2 years full time or 4 years part-time study.

Requirements:

Applications must be received by the end of a calendar year and counselling received before beginning your prerequisites.

Work to be assessed by the Assessment Committee for The Certificate Course.

Prerequisite (a): Essay of two A4 pages on any aspect of embroidery including your own background in embroidery.
Piece of own embroidery of Level 4 standard (Certificate Course)
Member of Embroiderers' Guild of South Australia Inc.

Prerequisite (b): Acceptable standard for prerequisite (a)
Planned outline of subject being undertaken to study.

Course of Study:

Written:

An in depth study of one embroidery subject, including its history and how the chosen subject has developed. Minimum length 4,000 words.

The collected data must be written as the thoughts and understanding of the participants.

These must be typed and the lines double spaced.

The final document must be A4 sized and in accordance with specified format.

To be presented for counselling before final assessment.

A final copy to be presented to the Embroiderers' Guild of S.A. Inc. library.

Practical:

1 -3 embroidery projects applicable to the subject being studied.

Samples applicable to the above project(s).

A colour copy of project(s) to be included with written format, A4 sized.

To be presented for counselling before final assessment

Submissions due in November

Cost:

\$100 when accepted into course of study after written acceptance has been received.

\$100 on completion of course before award granted.

Award:

Fellowship of The Embroiderers' Guild of South Australia Inc. for embroidery related research.
